

Placement Information for Theater Majors

All Theater Majors must prepare a one-minute monologue. These demonstrations allow faculty members a chance to get to know you as a person and become familiar with your command of your craft.

The monologues must be memorized, written for the stage, and reveal the actor's ability to create an original interpretation of the text based on character, objective, and obstacle.

- **Contemporary Acting** Majors need only audition with their one-minute monologue.
- **Musical Theater** Majors should also prepare a 16+ measure excerpt from standard musical theater repertoire accompanied by piano if possible.
- **Shakespeare** Majors should prepare a one-minute excerpt of a monologue from a Shakespeare play.

All videos should be framed to include the actor's full physicality.
