The business office assistant completes a range of responsibilities, such as:

- Working with others to manage accounts payable
- Processing daily deposits and receivables
- Processing data, maintaining records and files
- Working with the team to assist customers with registration, employees with onboarding, and others with retail transactions
- Assisting in a variety of areas within retail operations seasonally
